Greeting saints	Romans 16:14-16; 2 Corinthians 1:1-3; 2 Corinthians 13:12-14; Ephesians 1:1-3; Philippians 1:1-3; 4:22; Colossians 1:1-3; Hebrews 13:23-25;
Called to be saints	Romans 1:6-8; 1 Corinthians 1:1-3;

Romans 16:14-16 Salute Philologus, and Julia, Nereus, and his sister, and Olympas, and **all the saints which are with them.**

2 Corinthians 1:1-3 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, unto the church of God which is at Corinth, **with all the saints which are in all Achaia:**

2 Corinthians 13:12-14 **All the saints salute you.**

Ephesians 1:1-3 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, **to the saints which are at Ephesus,** and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:

Philippians 1:1-3 Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, **to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi,** with the bishops and deacons:

Philippians 4:21-23 **All the saints salute you,** chiefly they that are of Caesar's household.

Colossians 1:1-3 **To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse:** Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 13:23-25 Salute all them that have the rule over you, and **all the saints.** They of Italy salute you.

Romans 1:6-8 To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, **called to be saints:** Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 1:1-3 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that **are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints,** with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

Colossians 1:25-27 **Even the mystery** which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but **now is made manifest to his saints:**

Ephesians 1:17-19 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what **the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,**

Colossians 1:11-13 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be **partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:**

Ephesians 2:18-20 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but **fellow citizens with the saints,** and of the household of God

Romans 8:26-28 And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because **he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.**

Revelation 13:6-8 And **it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them:** and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

Revelation 13:9-11 He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. **Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.**

Revelation 14:11-13 **Here is the patience of the saints:** here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

Revelation 16:5-7 For **they have shed the blood of saints and prophets,** and thou hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy.

Revelation 17:5-7 And I **saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints,** and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration.

Revelation 18:23-24 And **in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints,** and of all that were slain upon the earth.

Ephesians 4:11-13 **For the perfecting of the saints**, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

Revelation 19:7-9 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for **the fine linen is the righteousness of saints**.

1 Corinthians 14:32-34 For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, **as in all churches of the saints**.

Ephesians 1:14-16 Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and **love unto all the saints**,

Colossians 1:3-5 Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of **the love which ye have to all the saints**,

Philemon 1:4-6 **Hearing of thy love and faith**, which thou hast toward the Lord Jesus, and **toward all saints**;

Ephesians 6:17-19 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and **watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints**;

Revelation 5:7-9 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and **golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints**.

Revelation 8:2-5 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with **the prayers of all saints** upon the golden altar which was before the throne. . . .And **the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints**, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand.

Romans 16:1-3 That **ye receive her in the Lord, as becometh saints**, and that ye assist her in whatsoever business she hath need of you: for she hath been a succourer of many, and of myself also.

1 Corinthians 6:1-3 Dare any of you, having a matter against another, **go to law before the unjust, and not before the saints?** Do ye not know **that the saints shall judge the world?** and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters?

Ephesians 3:17-19 May be able to comprehend **with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height**

Ephesians 5:2-4 But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, **let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints**

Romans 12:12-14 **Distributing to the necessity of saints;** given to hospitality.

Romans 15:24-26 But now I go unto Jerusalem **to minister unto the saints.**

1 Corinthians 16:1-3 Now concerning **the collection for the saints**, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye.

1 Corinthians 16:14-16 I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and **that they have addicted themselves to the ministry of the saints**

2 Corinthians 9:1-3 For as touching the **ministering to the saints**, it is superfluous for me to write to you:

2 Corinthians 9:11-13 For the **administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints**, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God;

1 Timothy 5:9-11 Well reported of for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have lodged strangers, **if she have washed the saints' feet**, if she have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed every good work.

Hebrews 6:9-11 For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that **ye have ministered to the saints**, and do minister

2 Corinthians 8:3-5 Praying us with much intreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the **fellowship of the ministering to the saints**.

Romans 15:30-32 That I may be delivered from them that do not believe in Judaea; and that my service which I have for Jerusalem may be **accepted of the saints**;

Philemon 1:6-8 For we have great joy and consolation in thy love, **because the bowels of the saints are refreshed by thee**, brother.

1 Thessalonians 3:12-13 To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, **at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints.**

2 Thessalonians 1:9-11 **When he shall come to be glorified in his saints**, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.

Jude 1:13-15 And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, **Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints**,
